
How To Draw Horse Markings Onto A Diagram



Red ballpoint pen

Everything that appears in white on the horse must be shown in red on the diagram.

1. Flesh marks

Flesh markings are entirely coloured in red. These are white markings that are on the flesh and not just hairs. Typically found around the nose area.

2. White hooves

Any part of the hoof that is white must be entirely coloured in red

3. Stars/stripes/snips/blazes/socks etc

Any white markings on the horses face or legs must be drawn in red with a single line to indicate the area of white as shown above. These are markings that are white hairs only.

4. White brand (freeze brand) - these are drawn in red

5. Fire brand - these are drawn in black

Black ballpoint pen

Everything which is not white on the horse must be shown in black on the diagram

1. Whorls

Whorls are indicated by an "X" These are often found around the centre of the face and sometimes on the neck or chest area. The exact location of the whorl marking is very important.

2. Brand marks

Brand marks must be drawn in black exactly as its shown on the horse
